The material developed in IO 1 will provide employers, business owners and managers with the tools they need to allow them to adapt to remote working practices within their business and to adapt their business model accordingly. A series of eight time-bound master-class sessions will be supplemented by a toolkit of digital learning resources, including video lectures, simulations, practical tipsheets, checklists and case studies to adapt their business model to a remote working environment. The Manual will be available as an interactive PDF as well As an offline version, through the MOOC. REMOTE WORKING TOOLKIT

FOR EMPLOYEES

The needs of employers and employees in remote working are quite different, and the proposed toolkit will support employees to manage successful remote careers. It will provide a complete suite of resources which addresses the issue from a holistic perspective. 18 Remote Career Planning Resources will comprise 3 core areas selected by partners, namely:

- 1) Skills for remote working readiness PREPARE;
- 2) Skills for remote job seeking SEARCH;
- 3) Skills for remote job retention SECURE.

The proposed resources will comprise a short video presentation; a factsheet with access to further resources and a learner handbook which will include a copy of the script and PowerPoint used in the video presentation and a set of self-reflection exercises for adult learners to complete to improve their career planning skills.

The learner handbook will be presented online as a downloadable PDF and also as a flip-book for online learning, but also will be available online through the MOOC in all partner languages
